

Kilograms & Grams Answers

1. What is 5kg in **grams** (g)?

1kg = 1000 grams

5 x 1000 = **5000g**

2. What is 2kg in **grams** (g)?

1kg = 1000 grams

2 x 1000 = **2000g**

3. What is 3.5kg in **grams** (g)?

1kg = 1000 grams

3.5 x 1000 = **3500g**

4. What is 8000g in **kilograms** (kg)?

1000g = 1kg

8000 ÷ 1000 = **8kg**

5. What is 2000g in **kilograms** (kg)?

1000g = 1kg

2000 ÷ 1000 = **2kg**

6. What is 5600g in **kilograms** (kg)?

$$1000\text{g} = 1\text{kg}$$

$$5600 \div 1000 = \mathbf{5.6\text{kg}}$$

7. Leo is baking a cake. The recipe says he needs to add 200g of sugar. What is that in **kilograms** (kg)?

$$1000\text{g} = 1\text{kg}$$

$$1000 \div 5 = 200$$

$$1 \div 5 = 0.2$$

$$200\text{g} = 0.2\text{kg}$$

The answer is **0.2kg**.

8. Jane has a rubbish sack that weighs 1.5kg. What is that in **grams** (g)?

$$1\text{kg} = 1000\text{g}$$

$$1.5 \times 1000 = 1500\text{g}$$

The answer is **1500g**.
