1. What is 4 litres in **millilitres** (ml)?

1 litre = 1000 millilitres

$4 \times 1000 = \mathbf{4000ml}$

2. What is 6 litres in **millilitres** (ml)?

1 litre = 1000 millilitres

$6 \times 1000 = \mathbf{6000ml}$

3. What is 7.5 litres in **millilitres** (ml)?

1 litre = 1000 millilitres

$7.5 \times 1000 = \mathbf{7500ml}$

4. What is 9000 millilitres in **litres** (l)?

1000 millilitres = 1 litre

$9000 \div 1000 = \mathbf{9 \text{ litres}}$

5. What is 5000 millilitres in **litres** (l)?

1000 millilitres = 1 litre

$5000 \div 1000 = \mathbf{5 \text{ litres}}$

6. What is 2900 millilitres in **litres** (l)?

1000 millilitres = 1 litre

$2900 \div 1000 = \mathbf{2.9 \text{ litres}}$

7. Emily had 0.8 litres of water in her bottle. What is that in **millilitres** (ml)?

1 litre = 1000 millilitres

$0.8 \times 1000 = \mathbf{800ml}$

8. John pours 500 millilitres of orange juice. What is that in **litres** (l)?

1000 millilitres = 1 litre

$1 \div 10 = 0.1 \text{ litres}$

$1000 \div 10 = 100 \text{ millilitres}$

0.1 litres = 100 millilitres

500ml = **0.5 litres**
